- 1 – LED Light
- 2 – Clamps
- 4 – Clamp screws long
- 4 – Clamp screws short
- 2 – Light screws
- 2 – Double bullet connector
- 4 – Cable Ties

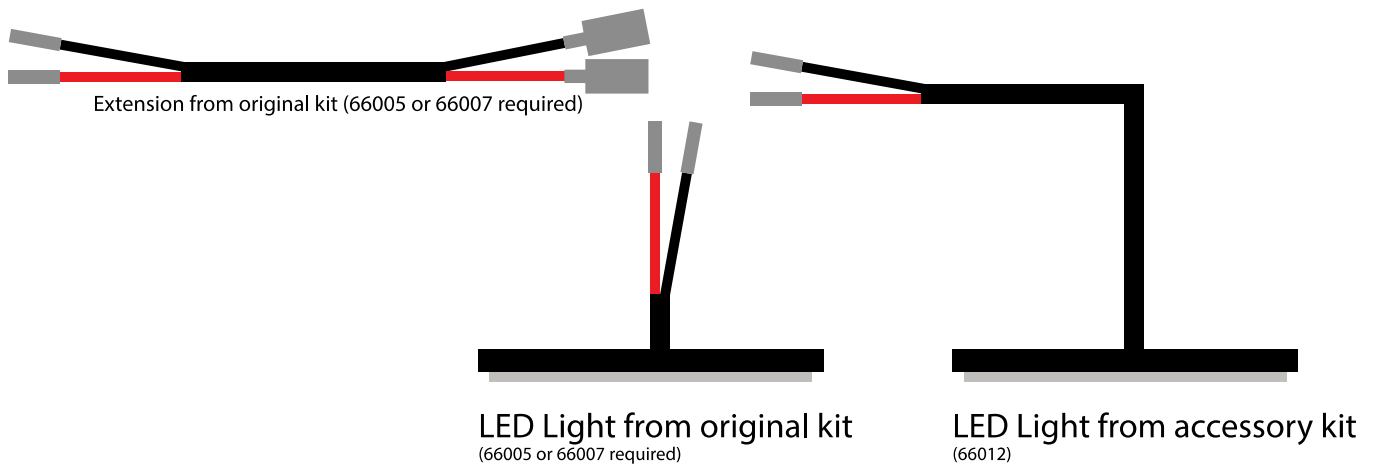
- Screwdriver

Wiring Diagram



Step 1: Determine the LED light mounting location

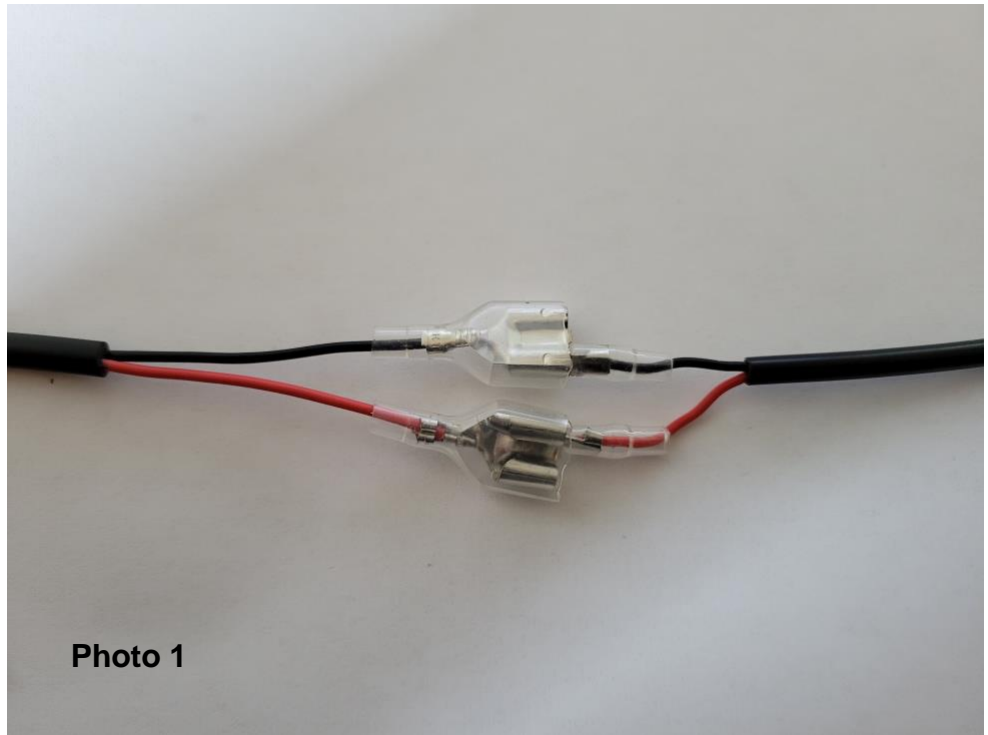
Mount toward the rear of the machine where it will not be obstructed or hit by items loaded on the rear rack.

Step 2: Hooking up the light

Your original 66005 or 66007 back up light kit may not have come with double bullet connectors on the LED light connection. If it did not, use the included double female bullet connectors and replace the existing single female bullet. Once the connector is replaced, hook up the red to red and black to black. **See Photo 1**

Step 3: Securing LED Light

Use the supplied clamps to mount the light towards the rear of the machine where the light will not be obstructed or hit by items loaded on the rear rack. **SEE PHOTOS 2 and 3.**



Step 4: Wrap wires

Use the included cable ties to secure all wires.
